One mission.

Thirty years ago, Jim and Terry Orcutt launched My Brother's Keeper with a prayer: "God, we want to bring your Love and Hope to people in need, but we don't know what to do. If you'll guide us, we'll always put your work first in our lives."

In 1988, Jim and Terry weren't sure HOW to best help their neighbors in need, but they knew WHY they were serving. They wanted to be a visible sign of God's love. It's why a crucifix or some other symbol of Christ is offered on every delivery.

In the early days, the Orcutt's delivered clothes. Today, My Brother's Keeper offers assistance with furniture, beds, food, Christmas gifts, heat, and even a driver's license program called "Credentials for Credibility."

Though our programs have evolved, our reason for being has never changed. Our mission is one sentence, thirteen words: "To bring the Love and Hope of Jesus Christ to those we serve." This clarity of purpose has served us well for 30 years and it will always guide us in the future.

Many hearts.

Without a doubt, the best decision Jim and Terry made was our mission. Their second best decision was to invite others to join them along the way. They welcomed people and allowed us to take on the mission as our own.

God used that spirit of inclusion to grow My Brother's Keeper into the ministry we are today with 2 locations, 9 vehicles, 12 staff, and 4,000 volunteers. We now make 9,000 deliveries a year and have made 140,000 total deliveries over the past three decades...what a miracle!

As impressive as these numbers are, My Brother's Keeper is so much more than a charity delivering the essentials of life to those in need. We're also a community of supporters which sustains one another in good times and in bad...truly a family!

The exciting thing about the My Brother's Keeper family is that it's always growing. Every day someone new gets involved...people from all faiths, backgrounds, and ages...grade school to grandparents.


A remarkable fact: more than 1,300 students volunteer at My Brother's Keeper each year. Thanks to them, our future is certainly bright.
