

Mentor Role Descriptions

The My Brother's Keeper Mentoring Program has three goals:

- 1. Mentors and mentees will enter into an authentic, respectful relationship
- 2. Mentees will improve their self-confidence, career readiness, and soft professional skills
- 3. Mentors, in partnership with the My Brother's Keeper community, will help mentees secure a job or internship aligned with their major

To accomplish these goals, My Brother's Keeper will utilize two types of volunteers:

Primary mentors professional who will take the lead in supporting a college junior or senior

through an authentic, respectful relationship with an expected

engagement period of 10 months

Flash mentors professionals available for one-time 1:1 meetings to share their

professional journey and answer career related questions

Primary Mentor Role Description

- Take the lead in supporting a college junior or senior through an ongoing, one-to-one relationship
- Build the relationship by planning and participating in activities with mentee, including volunteering at My Brother's Keeper one time per semester and attending My Brother's Keeper events
- Help mentee set career and personal goals and work toward accomplishing them
- Foster a relationship based on mutual respect
- Serve as a positive role model
- Build mentee's self-esteem and motivation

Time Commitment

- Attend an initial two-hour mentor training session
- Commit to a 10-month mentor-mentee relationship (October July)
- Commit to meeting mentee at least twice per month. One meeting per month must be in person one meeting can be remote.
- Communicate with the mentee weekly by phone call, text, or email in between meetings
- Attend additional training sessions during the engagement
- Attend mentor/mentee group events and program recognition events

Eligibility Requirements

- Committed to the mission of My Brother's Keeper "To bring the Love and Hope of Jesus Christ to those we serve."
- At least 30 years old
- Reside in eastern Massachusetts
- Working or recently retired professional with at least 10 years of work experience
- Interested in working with talented, motivated college students
- Able to follow through on the time commitments outlined above: meet with mentor at least twice per month over a 10-month period and communicate with mentor weekly in between meetings
- Communicate regularly with My Brother's Keeper Program Support team program, submit activity information, and take constructive feedback regarding mentoring activities
- Willing to adhere to program expectations
- Complete the application and screening process
- Attend mentor training sessions
- Pass a criminal background check
- Not be a user of illicit drugs
- Not use alcohol in an excessive or inappropriate manner

- Completed application
- Criminal history check
- Personal Interview
- Professional / personal reference check
- Attend two-hour mentor training

Flash Mentor Role Description

- Available for one-off virtual meetings with mentees to share professional story and offer career guidance
- Provide post-meeting feedback to mentors
- Support mentors <u>as requested</u> in their effort to assist their mentee
- Assist with networking

Time Commitment

- Approximately one hour for meeting with mentee (secondary contacts can set preferred availability and meeting capacity)
- Approximately 15 minutes for post-meeting recap with mentor

Eligibility Requirements

- At least 24 years old
- Interested in working with college students
- Working or recently retired professional with at least 3 years of work experience
- Dependable and consistent in meeting the time commitments
- Willing to communicate with mentor
